

Five Yard Quilt

52" x 68"

For this quilt you will need 1 yard each of 5 coordinating fabrics. The pattern is free with purchase of those 5 - 1 yard cuts. Backing requires just 3½ yards.

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Fabric (A) - Focus Fabric

Fussy cut 18 - 6½" squares

OR

Cut 3 strips - 6½" wide.....From strips - Cut 18 - 6½" squares

Fabric (B) - Frames around Focus Fabric

Cut 18 strips - 1½" wide.....From strips - Cut 36 - 1½" x 6½" rectangles

- Cut 36 - 1½" x 8½" rectangles

Fabric (C) - Second Block & Binding

Cut 3 strips 2" wide

Cut 3 strips 4½" wide

Cut 6 strips 2½" wide (binding)

Fabric (D) - Second Block & Inner Border

Cut 3 strips 2" wide

Cut 3 strips 4½" wide

Cut 5 strips 2" wide (inner border)

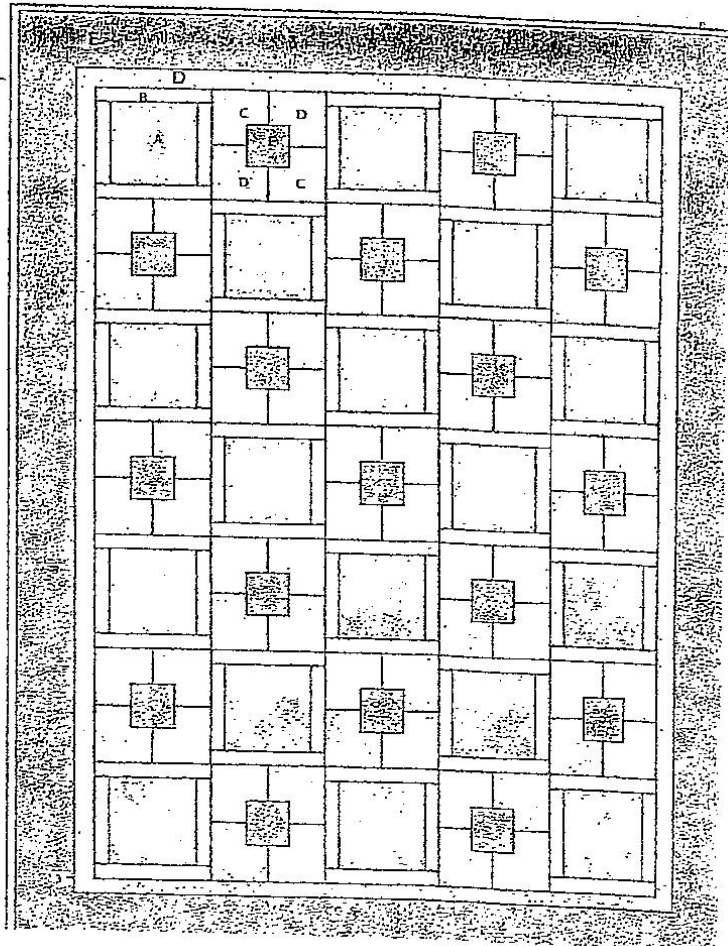
Fabric (E) - Center of Second Block & Outer Border

Cut 2 strips 3½" wide.....From Strips - Cut 18 - 3½" squares

Cut 6 strips 4½" wide (outer border)

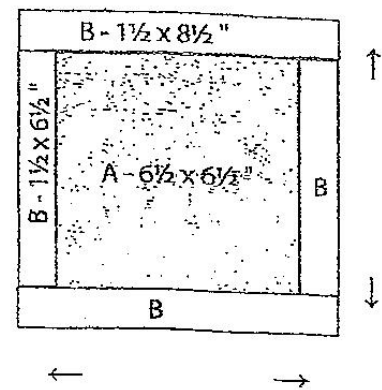
Quilt Layout 5 x 7 Blocks

By choosing 2/3 yd of a sixth fabric this pattern can easily be made twin bed size. When I made it there was enough fabric left over to make a baby quilt.



SEWING INSTRUCTIONS FOR BLOCK ONE - Use $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

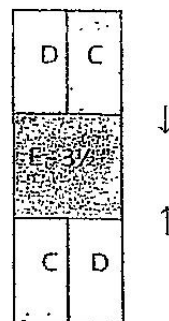
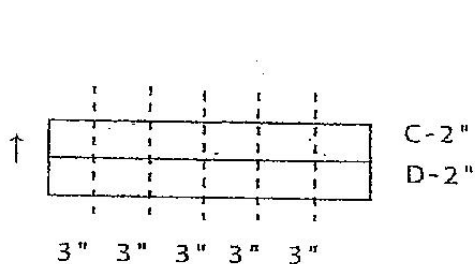
(1) Sew a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle of fabric B to opposite sides of the fabric A $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Press seams out. Sew a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle of fabric B to the top and bottom of fabric A $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Press seams out.



Block One - Make 18 - $8\frac{1}{2}$ " blocks

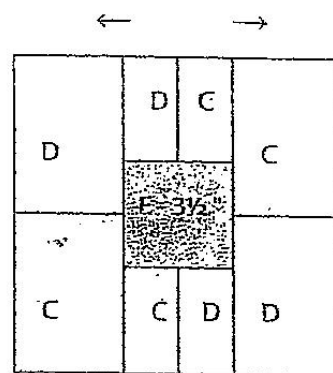
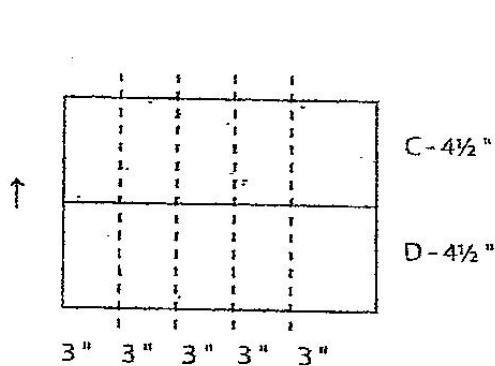
SEWING INSTRUCTIONS FOR BLOCK TWO

(2) Sew together lengthwise the 2" strips of fabric C & D. Press seams toward fabric C. Cut the strip sets into 36 - 3" wide pieces. Sew to the fabric E squares as shown for the center of block two. Press toward fabric E square.



Make 17 units

(3) Sew together lengthwise the $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strips of fabrics C & D. Press toward fabric C. Cut the strip sets into 36 - 3" wide pieces. Sew to the units made in Step 2. Press seams away from the center.



Block Two - Make 17 - $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Blocks

LAYOUT AND FINISHING

Sew blocks together in a 5 x 7 block layout. Start your layout in row one with block one. Alternate blocks throughout for each row. Add inner border (fabric D). Add the outer border (fabric E). Layer. Quilt. Bind with the $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips of fabric C. Backing is pieced horizontally.
